What we bring to you:

- ✓ Four hours with a small group of fun-loving goats, sheep, llamas, alpacas, ducks, geese, a tortoise (weather permitting), and more!
- ✓ Gated and no-gate options
- ✓ Feed machines for all of our petting zoos
- ✓ Exotic animals displayed in secured portable exhibits Options include camels, porcupines, lemurs, a tiger, macaws, coati mundi, and many others
- ✓ Complete set up and tear down before and after the event

What we need from you:

- ✓ A flat area, free from gravel or wood chips to set up the zoo or display, typically grass, cement, or asphalt (minimum 20'x20' for displays and small petting zoos)
- ✓ Space next to the display area for parking and use of our truck and trailer
- ✓ Reasonable access to fresh drinking water for our animals throughout the event
- ✓ Access to a dumpster to remove bagged waste at the end of the event
- ✓ An hour and a half before and after the event to safely set up and remove the display
- ✓ Any permits necessary for allowing the selected animals at your location

Tips for hosting a successful petting zoo:

- ✓ Call or email us to schedule your display as soon as you know you want to work with us, ideally two months or more in advance of the event date. Take into consideration that our holidays and some weekends tend to book over six months in advance.
- ✓ Provide us with a day-of-the-event contact that our staff may call, and any directions that will help us set up the way you want.
- ✓ Be mindful of the area you choose for hosting your petting zoo and how your guests will experience the event. Specifically, we recommend a more shady area where people can congregate to watch and pet the animals.
- ✓ The more information you provide to us in advance about your event or your needs, the better our service can be for you. Knowing how large the crowd will be, if we are taking tickets, where to set up, is all helpful.
