



# Pony Rides

Starting at \$565.00, plus tax and mileage

## What we bring to you:

- ✓ Four, six, or eight ponies that walk together on a circular sweep
- ✓ Up to four hours of fun for ages two through ten, under 100 pounds
- ✓ Perimeter fencing, seat belts, and the option for parents to walk next to riders for a more comfortable experience
- ✓ Two handlers to help children onto and off of the ponies, provide a safe, clean environment for everyone, and take tickets if needed (will not handle money)



## What we need from you:

- ✓ A flat area, free from gravel or wood chips to operate the ride, typically grass, cement, or asphalt (20'x20' for four ponies; 20'x30' for six ponies; 30'x30' for eight ponies)
- ✓ Space next to the ride area for parking and using our truck and trailer
- ✓ Reasonable access to fresh drinking water for our ponies throughout the event
- ✓ Access to a dumpster to remove bagged waste at the end of the event
- ✓ An hour and a half before and after the event to safely set up and remove the ride area
- ✓ Any permits necessary for allowing equine at your location

## Tips for hosting a successful pony ride:

- ✓ Call or email us to schedule your pony ride as soon as you know you want to work with us, ideally two months or more in advance of the event date. Take into consideration that our holidays and some weekends tend to book over six months in advance.
- ✓ Provide us with a day-of-the-event contact that our staff may call, and any directions that will help us set up the way you want.
- ✓ Be mindful of the area you choose for hosting your pony rides and how your guests will experience the event. Specifically, we recommend a more shady area where people can congregate to watch the ponies and wait for rides.
- ✓ The more information you provide to us in advance about your event or your needs, the better our service can be for you. Knowing how large the crowd will be, if we are taking tickets, where to set up, who will be riding, is all helpful.
